1.0 POLICY:

Grants or Gifts through Proposal: The Board encourages the development of proposals to private foundations and other sources of financial aid for subsidizing such activities as innovative projects, feasibility studies, long-range planning, and research and development. The criteria for such activities shall:

- A. Be based on an objective that relates to the mission, strategic aims, goals and objectives of the District.
- B. Provide measures for evaluating whether or not project objectives are being or have been achieved.
- C. Conform to state and federal laws and to the policies of the Board.

Donations: The Board gladly receives donations from businesses, industries, or the general public when it is of benefit to the educational process. Titled items and other items of a value of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) or more must be recommended to the Board for acceptance. All other donations may be accepted by the superintendent or designee at his/her discretion.

The superintendent, or designee, shall establish procedures to ensure compliance with this policy.
