

Ron N. Huff Master Welder Scholarship Application Guidelines

Through the generosity of Ron Huff's brother Jim, and his widow, Carla Huff, the Ron N. Huff Master Welder Scholarship is **presented to students in the Welding career major** who need funds to cover the cost of licensing and certification or equipment/tools package to prepare them for work.

Procedure

1. The scholarship is available to Metro Technology Center students who are **SCHEDULED TO COMPLETE a Career Major in Welding in the current school year**. Applicant must have a 90% in attendance or better and a 3.0 GPA or better.
2. All scholarship materials must be mailed together in one envelope. This includes letters of reference, transcripts, etc. **DO NOT STAPLE OR USE PAPER CLIPS. Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
3. All applications of students eligible for scholarship will be submitted by the instructor in one packet and mailed directly to:

4. All applications must be typed, word-processed, or written in legible handwriting. All applications must be complete for acceptance and review by the Metro Technology Centers Foundation, Inc. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
5. Completed application packets are **due IN THE FOUNDATION OFFICE no later than 4:30 PM FRIDAY, MARCH 29, 2019** for consideration. **Late or incomplete application packets will not be considered.**
6. The Metro Tech Foundation will make the final decision on scholarship awards. Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 03, 2019.
7. **A check for the monetary scholarship will be presented to the student at the Metro Tech Foundation Spring Banquet on Wednesday, April 24, 2019.**
8. One \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded.
