1.0 POLICY:

Metro Tech stakeholders, as defined in item A below, are eligible to enroll, on a space-available basis, in adult and career development courses conducted by the District at a fifty percent (50%) tuition cost under the following conditions:

- A. This policy applies to district residents 65 years of age or older, employees of Crooked Oak and Oklahoma City Public Schools, and eligible high school students residing within District boundaries.
- B. The individual satisfactorily completes the course in which he/she has enrolled.
- C. The individual shall pay the cost of books, supplies, and related fees.
