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1.0 POLICY:

The Board and the superintendent of schools shall operate as a team for continuous improvement of the District. Each will help to support, and to encourage the other in the performance of respective roles in order to meet the educational needs of the District. The Board shall serve as the policy-making body of the District. The superintendent shall serve as the executive officer of the Board and the chief administrator of the District.

The superintendent may expect the Board to perform in the following manner:

- A. Act in a fair, ethical, and responsible manner.
- B. Support, help, and encourage the superintendent in the performance of his/her duties.
- C. Furnish objective advice and counsel to superintendent.
- D. Advise the superintendent on areas of concern and allow the superintendent adequate time for response after being fully advised of all facts.
- E. Promptly refer criticism, complaints, and/or suggestions called to their attention to the superintendent for study and, if appropriate, recommendations.
- F. Consult with the superintendent prior to submitting in board meetings, proposed changes in policies, new policies, etc. Allow the superintendent and staff to give professional advice on such matters under consideration.
- G. Present personal criticism of school employees only to the superintendent. Such criticism shall not be presented in open meetings of the Board.
- H. Support school employees in the performance of their duties when policies are properly executed.
- I. Evaluate the performance of the superintendent in a fair, impartial manner.
