

1.0 POLICY:

The Board of Education embraces energy management and believes it to be its responsibility to ensure that every reasonable effort is made to conserve energy and natural resources, while exercising sound financial management, and recognizes the importance of adopting an energy management policy to govern this program. Energy management is the joint responsibility of the Board of Education, administration, faculty, staff and students. The Board of Education expects all employees to make a positive contribution to maximize energy management and produce real energy savings. Accurate records of energy consumption and cost will be maintained for each campus to provide verifiable performance information to the Board of Education.

The Superintendent is directed to develop procedures consistent with this policy.
