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1.0 POLICY:

Building and Grounds Management: The care, custody, and safekeeping of all Metro Technology Centers property will be the general responsibility of the superintendent. The superintendent will be responsible for:

- A. The constant review of each center's building needs, and when a building program has been approved by the Board of Education, for the supervision of new construction.
- B. The maintenance of Metro Technology Centers property and the operation of plants.
- C. Employment and training of maintenance personnel.
- D. Inventory of all Metro Technology Centers property costing more than \$1,000.

Inspection: School facilities will be clean, attractive, and serviceable for students and employees. The Board of Education directs the superintendent to implement procedures for a maintenance/management plan for the cleanliness, attractiveness, maintenance and repair and replacement cycle of buildings and grounds.
