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1.0 POLICY:

The Board of Education recognizes the need for strict security of buildings, and the control of entry into the buildings is a major part of that security. For that reason, the Board of Education directs that any code given to any individual to access a building will only be given on a need-to-access basis.

Buildings and grounds security will mean maintenance of a secured (locked) building, protection from fire hazards and faulty equipment, and safe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing, and heating equipment. The Board of Education encourages close cooperation with local police, fire and sheriff's departments and with insurance company inspectors.

An adequate key and security code control system will be established to implement this policy. Records will be kept in a safe place and under lock and key when required. Protective devices will be installed, when appropriate, to be used as safeguards against illegal entry and vandalism.

The failure to follow this policy will be considered willful neglect of duty.

The superintendent is responsible for having procedures developed to ensure this process is followed.
